











# Visitor Origins



- Just under half of attendees (44%) were residents from Canberra, with the largest proportion (53%) being from interstate.
- Amongst interstate visitors, around 34% were from Sydney and 33% from elsewhere in NSW.
- . Due to the small sample size of international visitors for this event, no statistically significant conclusions can be drawn on their origins.

## Visitor Origins




- New South Wales residents made up approximately 67% of all visitors at the Discovering Ancient Egypt exhibition.
  Around 51% of the NSW visitors were from Regional NSW.
- More than 38% of regional NSW visitors travelled from further than 3 hours away
- A further 43% travelled between 2 to 3 hours to get to Canberra

For the purpose of an indicative analysis, IER has assumed the following:


- 1 hour or less = under 100 km radius
- 1 hour to 2 hours = 100 200 km radius
- 2 hours to 3 hours = 200 300km radius
- . More than 3 hours = over 300 km radius


### AWARENESS OF THE DISCOVERING ANCIENT EGYPT EXHIBITION (PRIOR TO VISITING)



- Overall, around 90% of attendees at the Discovering Ancient Egypt exhibition were aware of it prior to their visit
- When comparing awareness by visitor origin, Canberra residents were more likely to be aware of the Discovering Ancient Egypt exhibition (96%) compared to residents from elsewhere.


### Visitor Experience

#### SATISFACTION & VALUE FOR MONEY BY AGE GROUP

Rated 4 or 5 - Satisfied



- Attendees at the Discovering Ancient Egypt exhibition indicated a very strong level of satisfaction, with 94% rating their overall satisfaction as a 4 or 5.
- For value for money, majority were satisfied/extremely satisfied with this element, with 88% of attendees rating this a 4 or 5.
- When assessed by age group, it shows that the exhibition delivered a highly satisfactory experience across a broad range of age groups. The value proposition was also relatively consistent across age groups.
