ACT Tourism Economy



T2030 – the ACT Tourism Strategy 2023–2030

- Year ending September 2024:
 - \$3.7 billion in visitor spend.

Government Ambition:

- \$4 billion visitor spend by 2026.
- \$5 billion visitor spend by 2030.



Aviation and the Canberra Airport



Aviation Stimulus Fund

- Enhanced lower-cost connections to Adelaide
- Improved international connections:
 - USA via Fiji
 - Qatar Airways
 - Continue to work towards New Zealand and Singapore



Telstra Tower Restoration



- Partnering with Telstra to restore and reopen Telstra Tower.
- Work underway on scope of offering (e.g., café, playground, retail and observation deck).



Raising London Circuit and Extending Light Rail



- Key enabling works to transform streetscape and strengthen connections nearing completion:
 - London Circuit East reopening in May 2025.
 - Light Rail works London Circuit West commencing shortly.



New Canberra Convention and Entertainment Centre Precinct



- Extensive engagement with industry undertaken to date.
- Functional Design Brief progressing.
- Commonwealth Government Partnership progressing.



Canberra Theatre Centre Transformation



- Infrastructure Canberra undertaking procurement activity for a delivery partner for new Lyric Theatre.
- First stage of the Theatre Centre transformation.



Kingston Railway Precinct



- Urban Renewal Precinct.
- New Railway Station.
- Faster journey times.
- NSW Government has procured new trains.
- CBR SYD rail corridor: 280,000+ passengers annually taking a trip in either direction.



Bruce Sports, Health and Education Precinct



- \$250m+ allocated by Commonwealth Government for AIS precinct.
- Site analysis and technical due diligence on preferred stadium site nearing completion.



Major Event Activity



- \$80 million+ in direct economic impact in 2024.
- Records crowds and significant proportion of interstate visitors for events in 2025.
- Further event announcements to come.
