China-bound Aussie wine exports plunge to \$12m from \$1b

Australia's wine exports to China have plunged to just \$12.4 million annually compared with [\\$1.3 billion](#) before Beijing imposed punishing tariffs in late 2020.

Australian wine exports fell 4 per cent to \$1.94 billion last year, industry body Wine Australia said on Tuesday. Exports to the UK, the second-biggest market, suffered a substantial 18 per cent fall to \$373 million.

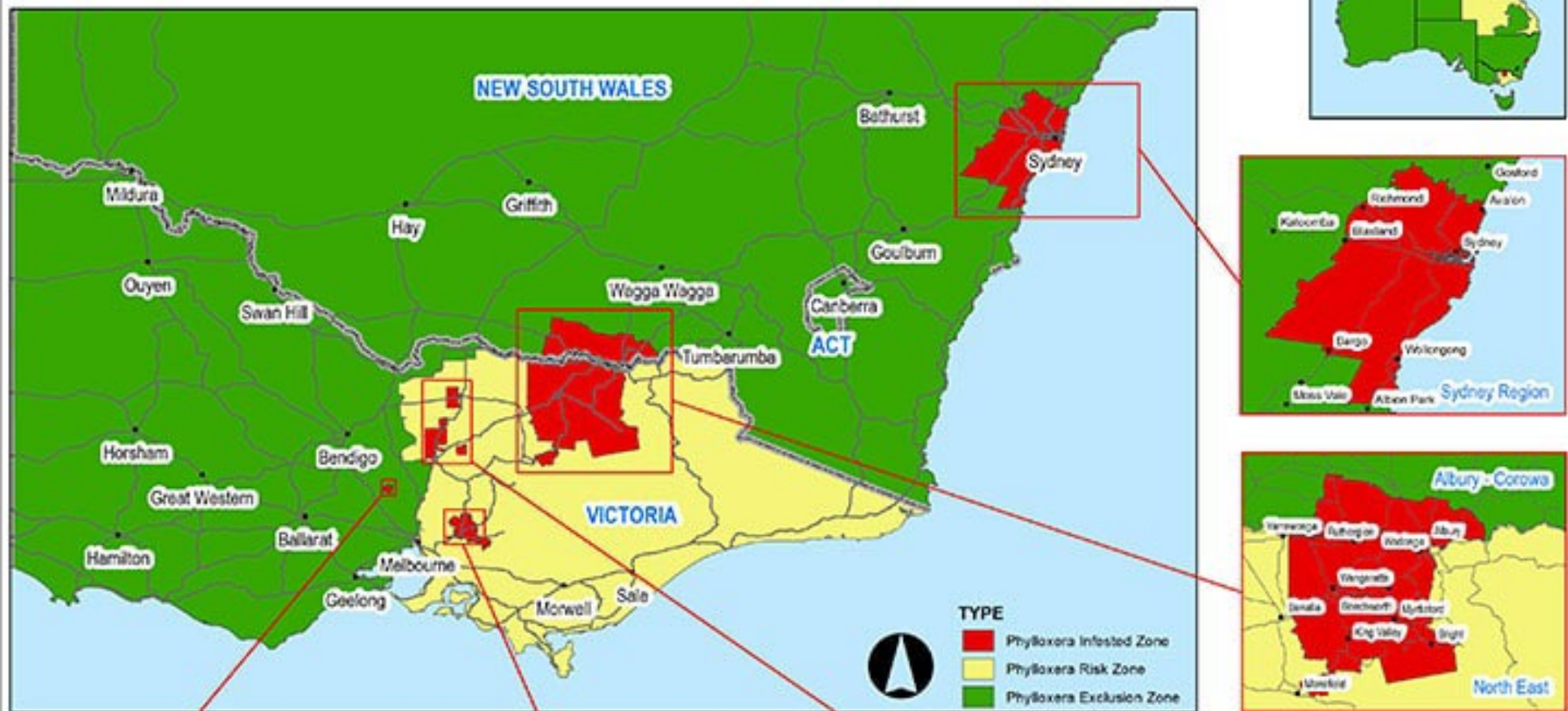

[Wine producers](#) have urged the federal government to [ramp up migration](#) as they face chronic staffing shortages ahead of harvest later this month.

South Australian Wine Industry Association chief executive Brian Smedley said wine producers in the state, which is responsible for nearly 60 per cent of Australian wine exports, are screaming out for staff.
